LADY MONARCH MOMENTS:

- Old Dominion is looking to snap a three-game losing streak in its Colonial Athletic Association opener against Virginia Commonwealth on Monday night.
- The Lady Monarchs fell 79-72 at Ole Miss Friday night dropping its third straight contest. Old Dominion has not lost three-in-a-row since the 2006-07 season with a 68-64 loss to Charlotte on Dec. 17, 2006, a 86-71 setback at Middle Tennessee on Dec. 19, 2006, and a 75-59 home loss to Tennessee on Dec. 22, 2006.
- Old Dominion closed out the non-conference schedule at 5-5 with a pair of wins over the A-10 (Dayton, Saint Joseph's), as well as the ACC (Virginia), West Coast (St. Mary's), and MEAC (Norfolk State), and a pair of losses to the SEC (Tennessee, Ole Miss) as well as to members of the ACC (Maryland), Big 12 (Texas), and Big 10 (Michigan State).
- Monday night's contest will be a rematch of the CAA Championship game in which the Lady Monarchs won its NCAA record 17th straight league title overcoming an 18-point deficit to win the crown with a 71-64 victory.
- Senior Tiffany Green, the Lady Monarch's leading scorer at 16.2 points per game, is coming off a career-high 24 point effort against Ole Miss. The Lady Monarch post also hauled in 13 rebounds for her fourth double-double of the year. Green has scored in double figures in all but one contest this season.
- Monday's contest will be aired on ESPN Radio 1310 with the Old Dominion men's contest at William & Mary airing on Star 94.1.

ABOUT VCU:

Virginia Commonwealth enters Monday's game with the top non-conference mark in the CAA at 10-2 and is riding a six game winning streak. VCU has not lost since a 56-48 setback at Richmond on December 3rd. The Rams only other loss was a 77-65 defeat at the hands of No. 6 North Carolina in

Chapel Hill back on November 16th. The Rams, who reached the second round of last year's WNIT, returns eight letterwinners and three starters. Among the returnees is Chesapeake native and senior center Quanitra Hollingsworth. Hollingsworth, who missed the last 11 games of last season with an achilles tendon injury, has returned to pour in a team-leading 14.8 points along with a team-leading 9.1 rebounds per game. Joining Hollingsworth in averaging double figures is senior forward Radoslava Bachvarova at 10.3 points per contest and junior guard Kita Waller at 10.0 points per game.

ALL-TIME SERIES WITH VCU:

The Lady Monarchs hold a 53-8 record in the all-time series with the Rams with Old Dominion winning the last 11 outings and 30 of the last 31. The ODU and VCU rivalry dates back to the 1969-70 season where the two teams squared off against each other each season until 1979. The rivalry renewed when VCU joined ODU in the Sun Belt Conference and continued when the Rams joined the CAA for the 1995-96 season. The Rams snapped a 35-game CAA Lady Monarch win-streak back on February 6th, 2003 at the Siegel Center. Old Dominion fell, 56-67, in their first CAA loss in nearly two years. Since then, the Lady Monarchs have rattled off 11 straight wins over Virginia Commonwealth.

LAST TIME VS. VCU:

T.J. Jordan celebrated her 22nd birthday in perfect fashion - helping cut down the nets after yet another championship. Jordan and Tiffany Green each scored 15 points and No. 14 Old Dominion rallied from an 18-point deficit to win its 17th consecutive Colonial Athletic Association tournament championship with a 71-64 victory over Virginia Commonwealth on March 16, 2008. Jazzmin Walters contributed 12 points and Shahida Williams, the tournament's Most Outstanding Player, had 10 for the top-seeded Lady Monarchs, who improved to 50-0 in CAA tournament games since joining the league before the 1991-92 season. It was the fourth CAA title for seniors Jordan and Williams. It was the third title for Green, who is a junior. Old Dominion coach Wendy Larry picked up her 500th career win at the school in the semifinals. But win No. 501 may have been even sweeter. Krystal Vaughn and D'Andra Moss had 16 points and 10 rebounds each and Radoslava Bachvarova added 15 for VCU, which had already set a school record for victories, easily surpassing the 21 it achieved during the 1986-87 season. The Rams had won six straight games before competing in the championship game for the first time. Old Dominion trailed 38-30 at halftime but quickly tied it at 41.

After the Lady Monarchs built a 50-45 lead, VCU responded with a 5-0 run to tie it at 50. From there, Old Dominion scored seven of the next nine points - four by Green and three by Jordan - to extend its advantage to 57-52 with 4:55 left. VCU never got within three the rest of the game. Bachvarova's third 3-pointer of the first half gave VCU a 34-16 lead with 6:04 remaining. But Old Dominion came right back with a 14-2 run to close to 36-30 before falling behind by eight at halftime. The Rams shot 56 percent from the field (15-of-27), including 6-of-9 from 3-point territory.

STOPPING THE SKID:

The Lady Monarchs are looking to end a three-game losing streak on Monday night against the Rams. Old Dominion has dropped contests #11/13 Tennessee (76-81), #15/16 Maryland (65-74), and Ole Miss (72-79). The Lady Monarchs last victory was on December 12th in a 74-51 win over Saint Joseph's.

SEEING DOUBLE:

Old Dominion senior post Tiffany Green has reached double figures in all but one game this season (Saint Joseph's). In her last outing, Green captured a career-high 24 points, while posting her fourth double-double of the year with 13 rebounds.

DISH IT TO ME:

Senior Jazzmin Walters isn't the only play maker on the roster. Fellow classmate Jen Nuzzo, who will also run the point at times, registered seven assists in ODU's last outing at Ole Miss, for a new career mark.

GETTING THE NOD:

Freshman Mairi Buchan record her first career start as the rookie center played in place of the injured Jessica Canady. Buchan ended the game with six points, five rebounds, and three assists. Buchan's start was the first the Lady Monarch rookie to see the starting line-up since the 2005-06 season. The last Lady Monarch freshman to receive a starting nod was current senior Jazzmin Walters, who had her first career start against Virginia Tech on Nov. 25, 2005 in her rookie campaign.

NON-CONFERENCE ENDS AT THE TED:

The Lady Monarchs closed out non-conference action at the Constant Center with a 74-65 setback to #15/16 Maryland on December 21st. Old Dominion finished the 2008-09 season at 3-2 in non-conference action at the Ted Constant Convocation Center with wins over #16/11 Virginia, Norfolk State, and Saint Joseph's, and losses to #11/13 Tennessee and #15/16 Maryland.

LOSSES IN-A-ROW AT THE TED:

Old Dominion fell in back-to-back games (#11/13 Tennessee and #15/16 Maryland) for the first time since dropping contests to top-ranked UConn (86-43) and #4 and national runner-up Stanford (69-61) during the Paradise Jam last Thanksgiving in St. Thomas. Old Dominion dropped back-to-back home games for the first time since falling three straight to Florida International (80-76) on December 21st 2005, #5 North Carolina in overtime (88-80) on December 29th, 2005 and top-ranked Tennessee (83-67) on January 2nd, 2006.

HOME COURT STREAK COMES TO AN END:

The Lady Monarchs saw its 29-game homecourt win streak come to a close in the 81-76 loss to #11/13 Tennessee. Old Dominion was tied along with the University of Hartford for the nation's longest active home win streak. The win streak dated back to the Dec. 30, 2006, 72-55, victory over national runner-up Rutgers. ODU's previous last home loss at the Ted Constant Convocation Center was also against Tennessee, 59-75, back on Dec. 22, 2006.

FAMILIAR FOE BREAKS HOME STREAK:

Tennessee has broken several of ODU's home court win streaks in the past. In addition to Thursday's 29-game home game win streak snapped, the Lady Vols also halted the Lady Monarch's 64-game home win streak in 1981, 33-game home win streak in 1999, and a 17-game home win streak in 1995.

OH SO CLOSE:

The five-point, 81-76, defeat was the closest loss for the Lady Monarchs in the Lady Vol's current 13-game win streak over Old Dominion. The next closest game was a 10-point, 68-58, setback back on Jan. 2nd, 2005. Old Dominion led as late as 1:57 in the game, holding on to a 71-70 edge. The game saw 12 lead changes and nine ties. Tennessee led by no more than seven in the contest

NO SOPHOMORE SLUMP:

Sophomore Jasmine Parker earned her first career start against #11/13 Tennessee back on December 18th. The 5-6 second-year Lady Monarch ended the night with 14 points as one of four Lady Monarchs in double figures going 5-of-9 from the field and 4-of-5 from beyond the arc.

ADDING DEPTH:

Sophomore Sierra Little made her first appearance of the 2008-09 season against #11/13 Tennessee. Playing 12 minutes, the sophomore Lady Monarch tied her career-high five five boards against the Lady Vols and added a pair of blocks and three points.

IMPROVING FROM THE STRIPE:

Old Dominion shot over 75 percent from the free throw line for the third time this season in its contest with the Lady Vols. The Lady Monarchs went 19-of-24 from the charity stripe shooting 79.2 percent, their second highest percentage this season. Seniors Jen Nuzzo and Jazzmin Walters each went perfect from the line going 3-of-3 and 2-of-2 respectively.

R-E-J-E-C-T-I-O-N:

Senior Tiffany Green is currently tied for ninth in the nation in blocks per game, averaging 3.0 per contest through the first nine games of the season. Louella Tomlinson of St. Mary's currently leads the nation swatting away 5.6 shot per game. Last season, Green led the CAA in rejections at 1.94 per game. She is currently fourth on the CAA All-Time Blocks Leaders List with 178 career swats.

CAREER NIGHT:

Sophomores Shadasia Green and Jasmine Parker each collected career-highs in the Lady Monarch's outing against Saint Joseph's. Parker led all scorers with a career-high 19 points, while Green posted her first career double-double with a career-high 14 points and career-tying 11 rebounds.

RANK 'EM UP - AP POLL:

Four opponents on the 2008-09 Lady Monarch slate are featured in the poll, including undefeated Texas at No. 4 and defending NCAA champion Tennessee coming in at No. 8. Also in the Top 25 are Maryland, the 2006 NCAA Champions, seated at No. 14 and Virginia at No. 16. The Lady Monarchs have ranked as high as No. 23 in the poll.

Four Lady Monarch opponents are also featured in the ESPN/USA Today Coach's Poll. Texas is the lone opponent featured in the Top 10 coming in at No. 4 this week. Tennessee enters the week at No. 12 with Maryland at No. 15 and Virginia at No. 16. The Lady Monarchs ranked as high as No. 20 in the poll.

POUR IT ON IN THE PAINT:

The Lady Monarchs scored 56 points in the paint against Norfolk State, two more points than the entire Norfolk State team combined in the 97-54 victory back on November 20th.

CAVALIER KILLER:

Something about playing the Virginia Cavaliers seems to bring out the best in senior guard Jazzmin Walters. Last season, Walters nailed the game-winning three-point shot against the Cavaliers with 4.8 seconds remaining in overtime to send the Lady Monarchs to the "Sweet 16" for the first time since 2002. In the rematch last week, Walters collected a career-high 24 points going 6-of-10 from the field and 11-of-12 from the line to help the Lady Monarchs to 78-70 upset victory over #16/11 Virginia.

Tiffany Green averaged 17.0 points and 8.7 rebounds, while Jessica Canady poured in 14.0 points and 9.0 rebounds over the three-day tournament in games against #14/13 Texas, St. Mary's and Dayton.

PRESEASON AWARDS:

Three Lady Monarchs were named to Preseason All-CAA teams. Senior forward/center Tiffany Green was a First Team selection. A First Team All-CAA pick a season ago, she averaged 11.4 points, 7.6 rebounds, and led the CAA in blocks. Senior guard Jazzmin Walters and junior Jessica Canady were Second Team picks. Walters led the CAA in assists, while Canady averaged 11.0 points as the Lady Monarchs' "sixth woman" and led the league in field goal percentage.

CAA PRESEASON POLL - WE'RE #1:

Old Dominion, which has captured the past 17 Colonial Athletic Association women's basketball titles, was picked to repeat as conference champion in 2008-09 according to a vote of the league's coaches, sports information directors and media. The Lady Monarchs, advanced to the "Sweet 16" and earned a 31-5 overall record last season, were followed in the voting by Virginia Commonwealth, James Madison, Drexel, Towson, UNC-Wilmington, Delaware, Georgia State, Northeastern, William & Mary, Hofstra, and George Mason.

HOME OPENERS:

In home openers, the Lady Monarchs are 29-11 including a 4-3 mark at the Ted Constant Convocation Center. Old Dominion defeated Virginia 78-70 in a rematch of the NCAA Second Round overtime game in their 2008-09 home opener on Nov. 21.

SEASON OPENERS:

The Lady Monarchs are 27-13 in season openers including this year's 93-63 victory over St. Mary's in the opening day of the World Vision Classic in Austin, Texas. The 30-point victory over the Gaels was ODU's largest in a season opener since its 82-26 victory over Towson during the 2001-02 season.

RACKING UP THE WIN COLUMN:

The Old Dominion Lady Monarchs finished last season with a 31-5 overall mark. It was the most wins for the program since the 1996-97 season when the Lady Monarchs captured a 34-2 overall mark and reached the championship game of the NCAA Tournament. Old Dominion has posted six 30+ win seasons in history.

500 AND COUNTING:

Old Dominion head coach Wendy Larry cracked a half-century mark last season. In Old Dominion's 74-51 CAA semifinal victory over fifth-seeded Towson, Larry earned her 500th win at the helm of the Lady Monarch program. To date, Larry has captured a 508-169 mark in her 22nd season as the head coach of the Lady Monarchs. 501 was just as sweet as it gave her and her team its 17th consecutive CAA title. Larry reached her 500th career win last season during the 2006-07 season against Chicago State and has a 557-200 overall mark in 25 seasons as the leader of the Old Dominion, Arizona State, and Virginia Wesleyan programs.

EXHIBITION RECAP - SHAW UNIVERSITY:

Junior Jessica Canady's 22 points led a trio of Lady Monarchs in double figures as the Old Dominion women's basketball team concluded the exhibition portion of its schedule with a 69-48 win over Shaw University on November 10th. Old Dominion held a 35-23 edge at halftime. Shaw was within six, 20-14, with 6:37 remaining in the first half, but the Lady Monarchs quickly established a double-digit lead shortly thereafter for good. The veterans continued to shine as senior Tiffany Green added in 13 and Shadasia Green contributed 10 points to go along with Canady's game-high 22 points. The posts helped Old Dominion outscore Shaw, 41-16, in the paint. Assist machines Jen Nuzzo and Jazzmin Walters dished out five assists apiece with Walters also collected five steals. Mairi Buchan led the newcomers with nine points and five boards. Old Dominion was untraditionally outrebounded, 43-38, by the Bears. Canady led the Lady Monarchs with six rebounds.

EXHIBITION RECAP - UNIVERSITY OF D.C.

The Old Dominion women's basketball rolled to a 53-point exhibition win on November 3rd at the Ted Constant Convocation Center with a 79-26 win over the University of D.C. Four Lady Monarchs reached double figures led by Preseason First Team All-CAA selection Tiffany Green with 17 points. Green went 5-of-6 from the floor and 7-of-9 from the stripe. The CAA leader in blocks a year ago also registered five rejections on the evening. The Old Dominion defense held the Firebirds to 20 percent shooting and the bench to just four points. LaQuanda Brandon chipped in eight points to lead the University of D.C. The Lady Monarchs used a 22-4 run, including a string of 13 unanswered points, to take a 24-6 edge with 7:43 remaining in the first half. Old Dominion cruised to a 40-12 halftime lead and ended the second half outscoring the Firebirds, 39-14. Joining Green in double figures were sophomore Jasmine Parker with 16, junior Jessica Canady with 15, and junior Jazzmin Walters adding in 11.

Canady, a Preseason Second Team All-CAA selection, went a perfect 5-of-5 from the charity stripe. The two Greens led Old Dominion on the boards as the Lady Monarchs outboarded the University of D.C., 41-29. Tiffany and Shadasia Green hauled in nine rebounds a piece.

HI MOM - I'M ON TV!:

A total of eight Lady Monarchs games will be televised this season. Comcast Sportsnet will air four games including the Lady Monarchs showdowns against national champion Tennessee on Dec. 18 and former NCAA champ Maryland on Dec. 21. Comcast will also air conference contests with Georgia State on Jan. 18 and James Madison on Jan. 25, and WSKY will air Old Dominion's road contest at William & Mary on Jan. 22, Delaware in the annual "Hoops for a Cure" game on Feb. 15, as well as the final home game and "Senior Day" against the Tribe on Mar. 4. The Lady Monarchs contest at Michigan State on Nov. 26 will be aired by the Big Ten Network, which is carried locally by Verizon FIOS.

COLONIAL DOMINANCE: Old Dominion has captured 17-straight Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) titles since joining the league from the Sun Belt Conference during the 1991-92 season. The Lady Monarchs are in the NCAA record books for capturing the most consecutive conference championships. In league play, Old Dominion holds a 311-17 overall record, which includes eight seasons of undefeated play. The Lady Monarchs hold a 161-2 record at home and a 150-15 road record. Only two CAA losses have occurred on Old Dominion's homecourt. The first was back at the ODU Fieldhouse, the former Lady Monarch homecourt from 1969-2002, against Richmond, now of the Atlantic-10, with a 70-74 defeat on February 19, 1992 and the second versus Delaware with a 70-73 setback on January 9, 2005. Five schools in the league have yet to beat the Lady Monarchs - Georgia State (6-0), George Mason (43-0), Northeastern (5-0), UNC-Wilmington (36-0), and Towson (12-0).

- Old Dominion kicked off the 2008-09 season with a 93-63 victory over St. Mary's in the opening day of the World Vision Classic. The victory brought the Lady Monarchs to 27-13 in season openers. Old Dominion's 30-point victory was the most in a season opener since their 82-26 victory over Towson to start the 2001-02 season.
- Old Dominion has now won back-to-back season openers (including last season's 76-68 victory over Middle Tennessee). It is the first time the Lady Monarchs have had back-to-back season opening victories since winning seven straight from 93-94 to 99-00.
- Junior Jessica Canady with her 13 points and 10 rebounds performed her first double-double of the season. It was the sixth double-double of her career.
- With her game-high 19 points, senior Tiffany Green has brought her career scoring total to 1,019. Green needs four more points to move into 25th on the all-time Lady Monarch scoring leaders list surpassing Aubrey Eblin (1995-1999).
- In her first career game as a Lady Monarch, freshman Mairi Buchan nearly registered a double-double. Buchan went 6-of-10 from the floor and 2-of-2 from the line to finish with 15 points as ODU's second leading scorer. She also hauled in nine boards.
- In addition to making her first career start, sophomore Shadasia Green set a new career-high mark in rebounds. Leading the Lady Monarchs, who outboarded the Gaels 57-35, 11 boards, Green reset her former mark of eight set against Delaware State back on Dec. 20, 2007.
- Three of the Lady Monarch freshman played in their first career games. Mairi Buchan played 22 minutes narrowly missing a double-double with 15 points and nine rebounds. Margaret Harvey saw 16 minutes of action registering three points and three assists. Rachel DeMita logged three minutes of time on the hardwood.
- Alena "Russia" Voronina set a new career mark in minutes played. Voronina logged 10 minutes in the ODU win over St. Mary's.

OXFORD, Miss. -- The Old Dominion women's basketball team tried to rally from a 10-point second half deficit behind the career-high 24 point night from senior Tiffany Green (Chesapeake, Va.), however the Lady Monarchs would close out the non-conference portion of its schedule at 5-5 following a 79-72 setback at Ole Miss on Friday night.

The first half endured six ties and six lead changes before Old Dominion controlled the later part of the opening stanza. With Ole Miss leading 23-20 with 7:22 left in the half, Old Dominion produced an 11-0 run fueled by six straight points by sophomore guard Jasmine Parker (Norfolk, Va.). Parker capped off the run hitting a four-point play and creating a turnover on the ensuing play to put the ball up and in on a lay-up to give Old Dominion a 33-27 edge with 5:34 remaining in the opening stanza.

Old Dominion held a five-point, 54-49, advantage with 11:36 remaining in the game, however Ole Miss took control of the game for the next five minutes. Thomas drained back-to-back three's cutting Old Dominion's lead to 54-52 with 11:13 remaining. Her second three began a 15-0 run returning the edge back to the Lady Rebels for good. Green finally stopped the run with a pair of free throws followed by ODU's first field goal in nearly five minutes.

The Lady Rebels led by 10 with 5:22 left, but the Lady Monarchs had a late surge to keep the game within reach. A 9-2 run by Old Dominion closed the gap with Green collecting back-to-back lay-ups and senior Jazzmin Walters connecting on all three of her free throws after getting fouled from beyond the arc.

Walters went to the line again with Ole Miss clinging to a four-point, 75-71 edge with 30 seconds remaining. The 5-2 senior connected on the first attempt of a two-shot award, but missed the second, leaving the Lady Monarchs to foul down the stretch. Thomas would hit four free throws for Ole Miss for the final margin.

Green was one three Lady Monarchs to collect double figures in the loss. In addition to Green's career-high 24 points, sophomore Shadasia Green registered a career-high 15 points. Also scoring in double figures was Walters with 15 points. Green also led with a game-high 13 rebounds for her fourth double-double of the season.
