ODU Hosts Final Game at Foreman Field

> Old Dominion spotted North Texas a 28-0 first half lead before storming back to defeat the Mean Green 34-31.

> ODU hosts VMI in the final game at Foreman Field at S.B. Ballard Stadium. VMI is coming off a 49-13 loss to Furman.

> The 28 point deficit is the largest comeback in school history. The previous biggest comeback was 26 points, when ODU erased a 47-21 New Hampshire lead to win 64-61.

> It's a broken record, but Travis Fulgham continued his surge the last seven games, leading ODU with eight catches for 155-yards and a touchdown. He scored a touchdown in his seventh straight game, breaking his own school record he set in 2016.

> Blake LaRussa Passed for 301-yards, notching his third-straight 300-yard game and registered two touchdown passes. He's tossed a touchdown in eight-straight games and now has 16 on the year.

> True freshman Lala Davis rushed for 50-yards and two touchdowns, including the game-winner with 15 seconds left.

> Lawrence Garner returned after missing the previous three games with an injury to record a game-high 11 tackles. He added his first career interception, which set up a field goal, had a forced fumble and tackle for loss.

> Oshane Ximines notched a career-best nine tackles, had 1.5 sacks, two tackles for loss and three QB hurries. Ximines broke his own school record with 10 sacks on the season and is second among active FBS players with 31 career sacks.

> Defensive end Tim Ward had five tackles, two tackles for loss and a sack on the final play of the game. Ward has a sack in three-straight games.

> Sophomore kicker Nick Rice kicked a pair of field goals, 48 and 37, and has made his last nine kicks after starting the year 3-for-7.

> ODU returns a program high 21 seniors, including first-team All-Conference USA performers in Oshane Ximines and Isaiah Harper. Harper was also named the C-USA Special Teams Player of the Year.

> Head Coach Bobby Wilder is the 11th longest tenured head coach in the FBS and the second longest in Conference USA. Rick Stockstill of Middle Tennessee leads all C-USA coaches. Stockstill is in his 13th season with the Blue Raiders. Kirk Ferentz is the longest tenured head coach in the country in his 20th year at Iowa.

Bobby Wilder
Head Coach
Maine, 1987
75-44 (10th Year)

Bobby Wilder begins his 12th season as head coach at Old Dominion University. Wilder, the only coach in program history, grew the football program from the best FCS start-up to an FBS program in just six years and a FBS bowl champion in eight years. Hired on February 13, 2007, Wilder led the Monarchs to a 17-5 record in the first two seasons in program history, a 2012 Colonial Athletic Association Championship, and a .500 season in ODU's first season playing a Conference USA Schedule, and a bowl championship in just the Monarchs' third season of FBS.

The Monarchs begin their 10th season under Wilder's leadership in 2018 and the final season in Foreman Field at S.B. Ballard Stadium before the stadium goes under a major reconstruction before the 2019 season. Wilder has led the Monarchs to a 72-37 record in nine seasons, two playoff appearances and the program's first bowl game in 2016.

In the summer of 2018, Wilder was inducted into the Maine Sports Hall of Fame. The induction into the hall of fame was not only due to Wilder's coaching prowess, however, the 30-year coaching veteran was a multi-sport athlete in high school in Madison, Maine, earning All-State honors in football and basketball, before starring at the University of Maine. Wilder graduated as the school's all-time leader in passing.

Wilder will begin ODU's 10 season of football as the 11th longest tenured head coach in the country and the second longest tenured coach in Conference USA (Rick Stockstill, Middle Tennessee).

Wilder led the Monarchs to a 10-3 record and a 24-20 win over Eastern Michigan in the Popeyes Bahamas Bowl. ODU landed a bowl game in their eighth season of football and just second season of bowl eligibility. ODU was one of 26 FBS programs to total 10 or more wins in the 2016-17 season. The Monarchs won nine of their last 10 games and finished the season on a six-game winning streak, tied for the sixth longest winning streak in the country.

ODU had 12 players featured on the Conference USA all-conference teams, while senior's TJ Ricks, Rashaad Coward and Zach Pascal will play in all-star games.

The Monarchs finished in the top-10 in the country in six categories, including second only to Western Michigan in fewest turnovers with just 10. ODU tied for fourth in FBS with a +13 turnover margin. Wilder helped guide quarterback David Washington to one of just two FBS quarterbacks to throw 30 or more touchdown passes and five or less interceptions (Zach Terrell/Western Michigan).

The Monarchs made an immediate splash in their first season in Conference USA, defeating the defending C-USA Champions Rice in the first conference game in school history. Wilder led ODU to a 6-6 overall record and went 4-4 in league play, including winning three-straight games to end the season.

In 2013, the Monarchs began their transition to FBS and Conference USA, playing five FBS opponents, the first five in school history. ODU finished the season 8-4, completing its first unbeaten season at home, going 6-0 and defeating Idaho 59-38 to deliver the programs first victory over an FBS school. For the second-straight season, the ODU offense averaged more than 40 points a game, averaging 42.3 points per game, which would have ranked seventh among FBS schools.

Wilder led the Monarchs to a school-record 11-2 mark in 2012.

Under Wilder's tutelage, the Monarchs led the FCS in scoring offense, total offense and passing offense in 2012 as the Monarchs won the Colonial Athletic Association Championship in their final season in the

FCS. In the always tough CAA, ODU defeated four ranked opponents and was ranked in the top-10 all season.

ODU earned the No. 4 national seed in the FCS Playoffs, advanced to the quarterfinals and ranked No. 6 in the final "The Sports Network" and coaches polls.

Top honors were not just awarded to Wilder's players, as Wilder was named American Football Monthly Coach of the Year and CaptainU Coach of the Year. In 2011, the Monarchs concluded the year at 10-3 overall and ranked No. 10 in The Sports Network/Fathead.com and FCS Coaches Final Polls, the fastest climb to the top-10 of any start-up program. In the first season of conference play in the Colonial Athletic Association, considered by many the toughest FCS conference in the nation, ODU went 6-2 against league opponents. Picked to finish 10th in the CAA Preseason Poll, ODU ended the year in a tie for second place in the CAA, a conference which sent five teams to the post-season. The Monarchs were among those five teams advancing to the FCS playoffs where they defeated MEAC Champions Norfolk State in first round action and advanced to the second round of the playoffs against Georgia Southern in one of the most thrilling games of the Division I Football Championships.

The 2011 season also brought a host of accolades for the program. In addition to 11 Monarchs being honored as All-CAA student-athletes, senior defensive lineman Ronnie Cameron was named the CAA Defensive Player of the Year. Cameron and punter Jonathan Plisco brought home numerous All-America honors and freshman quarterback, Taylor Heinicke, was the runner-up for "The Sport Network's" Jerry Rice Award as the FCS' top freshman and was honored as the "College Football Performance Awards" National Performer of the Year.

Additionally, Wilder was named "College Sports Madness" National Coach of the Year and finished third in voting for the Eddie Robinson National Coach of the Year Award.

Wilder and his staff's inaugural season of play at the Football Championship Subdivision level went well beyond expectations. From the celebrated kickoff versus Chowan, to the heart pounding first FCS road victory against Jacksonville, to ensuring a winning season at Savannah State, to extending the win-streak to six in the season finale at VMI, history was made every step of the way. The Monarchs concluded the 2009 season at 9-2 overall.

Prior to his arrival at ODU, Wilder served on the Maine staff for 17 years and was promoted to assistant head coach and offensive coordinator in 2000, before moving to associate head coach in 2001.

Wilder was named the Assistant Coach of the Year by the Gridiron Club of Greater Boston in 2004, which is presented annually to the top assistant coach in New England.

A 1987 graduate of Maine with a degree in physical education, Wilder captained the Black Bears to the Yankee Conference Championship his senior year. An All-New England quarterback in 1985, he left Maine as the school's all-time leading passer with 4,493 yards, and is currently sixth behind Mike Buck, Emilio Colon, Fein, Eaton and Whitcomb on the career passing list. Wilder coached four of those former players and played with the fifth.

Upon graduation, Wilder served as a graduate assistant coach for two seasons under Jack Bicknell at Boston College, where he earned his master's degree in educational administration in 1990.

Senior Profiles

Justin Cooper – TE – Chester, Va./Thomas Dale

A core special teams player, Cooper leads the Monarchs with eight special teams tackles. He has played in all 10 games this season with two starts at tight end. Cooper, who earned a scholarship over the summer, started his career as a walk-on.

Jeremy Cox – RB – Hope Mills, N.C./South View/Fork Union

The second all-time leading rusher in ODU history, Cox has struggled with injuries this season, playing in seven games rushing 83 times for 327-yards and three touchdowns. Cox carried 20 times for 130-yards and two scores in ODU's upset of No. 13 Virginia Tech. He has 2,049 career rushing yards.

Justice Davila – S – Erial, N.J./Timber Creek

Davila ranks sixth in ODU history with 216 career tackles. He finished third on the team with a career-high 89 tackles as a sophomore. He notched his first career interception this season at East Carolina and is second in career pass breakups with 19.

A.J. Davison – OL – Rohnert, Calif./Rancho Cotate

A two-year starter at right guard, Davison has started all nine games he played in after missing the season opener at Liberty with an injury. He has played in 21 career games, starting 18.

Jonathan Duhart – WR – Midlothian, Va./Manchester

Duhart ranks fourth in ODU history in career receptions with 173, and in receiving yards with 2,546. He leads ODU and Conference USA with 64 catches and is second in C-USA with 927 receiving yards, while hauling in eight touchdown receptions. He returned to ODU following a medical redshirt after breaking his foot in the second game last season.

Travis Fulgham – WR – Ashburn, Va./Broad Run

Fulgham has caught on fire the last seven games, catching 50 passes for 897-yards and seven touchdowns the last seven games. He had five catches for 64-yards the first three games combined. Fulgham leads C-USA with 961 receiving yards and broke his own school record with a touchdown catch in seven-straight games. For his career, he has 120 catches for 1,922 yards and 13 touchdowns. Fulgham started his career at ODU as a walk-on.

Jordan Glover – CB – Virginia Beach, Va./Princess Anne

A walk-on fifth year senior, Glover has appeared in two games in his career, recording one tackle. Glover has been the consummate team guy in his five years at Old Dominion.

Isaiah Harper – WR – Chesapeake, Va./Grassfield

The 2017 Conference USA Special Teams Player of the Year, Harper returned three kickoffs for touchdowns in 2017 and was 10th in FBS in kick return average. This season has become even more involved in the offense, catching a career-high 44 passes for 426-yards and a touchdown, while still operating as a dangerous return man.

Chad Hendricks – OL – Blackstone, Va./Nottoway

A former walk-on, Hendricks was a three-year starter at offensive tackle before knee injuries ended his career earlier this year. He played in six games, starting five at right tackle before a third knee injury forced him to retire from football. He played in 35 career games, starting 26.

Ryan Londree – DL – Charlottesville, Va./Albemarle

Londree has been a valuable piece to the defensive line as a versatile player able to play both tackle and end. He has a career-high 13 tackles this season and 25 for his career. He has two career starts.

ODU Fall in C-USA Opener, 28-20

NORFOLK, Va. -- Old Dominion fell to FIU, 28-20, in the weather-delayed home opener on Saturday night at Foreman Field at S.B. Ballard Stadium. The game was also ODU's first Conference USA game of the season.

Old Dominion (0-2, 0-1 C-USA) jumped out to a 17-0 lead early in the second quarter behind a pair of touchdown receptions from Jonathan Duhart, who finished the game with three receptions for 150 yards and two touchdowns.

However, FIU (1-1, 1-0 C-USA) scored a pair of touchdowns late in the first half to close the gap to 20-14 at the break.

Following an hour and 53-minute delay during halftime due to lightning, the Panthers outscored ODU, 14-0, in the second half to pull out the victory. The Monarchs had an opportunity to potentially pull even with under four minutes to play, but Blake LaRussa's pass to Travis Fulgham in the endzone fell incomplete.

ODU struck first with a six play, 75-yard drive capped with a four-yard touchdown pass from Steven Williams to Jonathan Duhart. The key play of the drive was a Williams to Duhart completion for 63-yards to convert a third and six.

The Monarchs added to the lead with an 83-yard touchdown toss from Blake LaRussa to Jonathan Duhart to make the score 14-0. The play is the fourth longest completion in school history, and career longs for both players.

Nick Rice added to the score with a 30-yard field goal early in the second quarter.

James Morgan hit C.J. Worton for 47-yard to pull FIU to within 17-7.

Rice added to the lead with a 39-yard field goal to push the lead to 20-7 midway through the second quarter.

The Panthers cut into the lead with a James Morgan to Tony Gaiter IV 11-yard touchdown pass with 14 second left in the first half to make the score a 20-14 at the break.

La Russa completed 8-of-15 passes for 143 yards and a touchdown for the game, while Steven Williams went 11-for-22 for 160 touchdowns and a touchdown.

Defensively, Lawrence Garner posted a game-best 16 tackles. Oshane Ximines had six tackles, three tackles for loss and two sacks.

NORFOLK, Va. – In front of a record crowd of 20,532, Old Dominion University football stunned No. 10/13 Virginia Tech 49-35 Saturday evening in Norfolk. Junior quarterback Blake LaRussa entered the game in ODU's second offensive series and threw for 495-yards, four touchdowns and rushed for one.

The win is ODU's first over a power-five opponent since restarting football in 2009.

After Virginia Tech tied the score at 35, the Monarchs retook the lead on a 29-yard touchdown pass from LaRussa to Jonathan Duhart to give ODU a 42-35 lead with five minutes remaining.

The Hokies drove to the ODU 21 but a fourth down pass from Willis fell incomplete. The Monarchs iced the game with a 40-yard touchdown run from Jeremy Cox for a 49-35 final.

Chamarri Conner got the scoring started for Tech with an 87-yard touchdown run one play after an ODU punt to put the Hokies up 7-0.

ODU tied the score on its following drive, going 75-yards in six plays capped by a 14-yard touchdown pass from LaRussa to Duhart. The big play on the drive was a 20-yard scramble by LaRussa and a 37-yard completion from LaRussa to Hasaan Patterson.

The Hokies took the lead with a Josh Jackson to Sean Savoy touchdown 28-yard touchdown pass midway through the second quarter.

The Monarchs made it a 14-14 game at halftime with a four-yard score from LaRussa to Duhart.

Steven Peoples helped Tech to a 21-14 lead with a one-yard score early in the third quarter, but the Monarchs came right back with a 65-yard drive capped by a one-yard run from LaRussa to tie the score at 21.

Damon Hazleton took Tech's first play of their following drive for a 72-yard touchdown catch, but once again ODU hung around with a 25-yard strike from LaRussa to Fulgham to once again knot the score at 28.

ODU forced Virginia Tech into a three and out, ODU took its first lead of the night on a 15-yard run from Cox. LaRussa to Duhart for 27-yards set up the touchdown run. ODU's win marks the first time a Conference USA team has knocked off a ranked opponent since Houston defeated No. 22 Penn State in 2012.

GREENVILLE, N.C. - Jake Verity kicked a 38-yard field goal with 46 seconds left to give East Carolina a 37-35 win over Old Dominion Saturday evening in Greenville.

The Pirates had first down on the ODU 24 when Justice Davila looked like he sealed the game for the Monarchs with an interception, but the play was ruled incomplete. Three plays later Verity kicked the game-winner.

The Pirates got the ball back with 2:02 left and Reid Herring converted a fourth and 10 for 16-yards to Deans, and then ECU got another first down on a pass interference penalty before Davila's near game-ending interception.

East Carolina got on the board first as Anthony Scott ran in from four-yards out to cap a 13 play, 75-yard drive for the 7-0 Pirates lead.

The Monarchs responded quickly with a 20-yard touchdown pass from LaRussa to Fulgham. LaRussa hit Duhart on passes of 21 and 24-yards before the TD strike to Fulgham.

Reid Herring came back for ECU and hit Trevon Brown for a 46-yard touchdown pass to put the Pirates back on top 14-7.

With the Pirates driving, Sean Carter intercepted Reid Herring's pass and returned it 75-yards to the ECU five. Three plays later Jeremy Cox pushed in from a yard out to tie the score at 14.

ECU retook the lead with a 12-yard touchdown pass from Herring to Deondre Farrier for a 21-14 advantage early in the second quarter.

Nick Rice cut the ECU lead to four with a 23-yard field goal with four minutes left in the first half.

Following an ECU three and out, ODU drove 47-yards in two minutes for a 28-yard field goal by Rice to cut the halftime lead to 21-20.

NORFOLK, Va. -- Old Dominion overcame a 28-0 first-half deficit to defeat North Texas, 34-31, on Saturday at Foreman Field at S.B. Ballard Stadium.

Lala Davis punched in a 1-yard touchdown rush with 15 seconds remaining for the game-winning score. Old Dominion (3-7, 2-5 C-USA) outscored North Texas (7-3, 3-3 C-USA), 24-3, in the second half and ended the game with 17 unanswered points.
