ABOUT OLD DOMINION:

The Lady Monarchs are looking put their 0-2 record behind them and look to Tuesday's home game against Penn State for their first win of the 2005-06 season. Old Dominion fell 56-93 to #1/2 Duke and had only one day off in between before heading to Blacksburg, Virginia to face the Virginia Tech Hokies. Senior guard Lawona Davis notched her first double-double of the season with 11 points and 10 rebounds and sophomore T.J. Jordan came off the bench for a game-high 18 to spearhead a late Lady Monarch rally as Old Dominion came up just short of the comeback in the 76-69 loss to Virginia Tech. Trailing by as many as 12 in the second half, Old Dominion was able to close to within three in the closing minutes. Old Dominion's second half rally was not the only one of the game. The Lady Monarchs overcame a 13-point deficit with 3:25 remaining in the first half to close on a 13-4 run and enter the locker room down only, 39-35. Davis scored nine of her 11 points in the second half. Typically known for driving to the basket, she opened the second half draining back-to-back threes. Jordan shot both 50 percent from the floor and from beyond the arc. She shot 6-for-12 from the field and 4-for-8 from downtown. Two other Lady Monarchs joined Davis and Jordan in double figures. Junior Paula Muxiri in her first career start poured in 11, as did junior Sherida Triggs. Triggs was one rebound shy of having her second straight double-double against the Hokies as she finished the night with nine.

ABOUT PENN STATE:

Young is one adjective to describe the 2005-06 version of the Lady Lions. Penn State returns just one starter in Amanda Brown and four letterwinners from last year's team which went 19-11 overall, 13-3 in BIG 10 action, and went on to the NCAA Tournament falling to Liberty in the first round. No seniors grace this year's roster and boast three juniors, three sophomores, and four freshmen. Brown, a 6-4 junior, averaged 7.2 points and 6.2 rebounds a season ago. Today she leads the team with 15.7 points and 7.3 boards per outing. All together five Lady Lions are averaging double digits including Junior transfer from N.C. State Kamel Gissendanner (13.3), rookies Brianne O'Rourke (11.3) and Mashea Williams (10.7), and sophomore Adrienne Squire (10.3). The Lady Lions enter the Ted Constant Convocation Center 1-2 with the lone victory coming last Tuesday in Pittsburgh with a 81-62 victory over Duquesne. Penn State also opened the season against #1/2 Duke, falling 67-93, and also dropped a 59-62 contest to Villanova.

THE SERIES WITH PENN STATE:

Old Dominion holds a 5-4 edge in the all-time series. The two teams have played each other annually the last six years and have traded between the win-loss columns. The Lady Monarchs won the first three meetings starting with a 95-67 victory at the Coca-Cola Women's Classic in 1979 followed by NCAA victories in 1983 and 1984. Old Dominion fell 77-89 in December of 1998 before the current series began in the 2000-01 season at the State Farm Tip-Off Classic on a neutral court. Since then, its been the home team walking away with the win including ODU's first win over a ranked team at the Ted Constant Convocation Center.

CAA PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

JUST LIKE MIKE:

T.J. Jordan has come off the Lady Monarch bench to lead the team in scoring in the first two games of the season. Against #1/2 Duke, the sophomore guard tallied 17 points shooting 7-of-8 from the field and playing a game-high 30 minutes. She followed by shooting both 50 percent from the field and three-point land in Tuesday's loss at Virginia Tech. Collecting a game-high 18 points she shot 6-of-12 from the floor and 4-of-8 from beyond the arc. She leads the team in scoring at a 17.5 ppg clip and is shooting 37.5 from three-point range.

A WAY TO START:

Junior forward Paula Muxiri earned her first career start in last week's loss at Virginia Tech. After her line against #1/2 Duke in the season opener - 12 points, 5-8 from the floor, 2-2 from the line, 3 steals - the coaching staff inserted into the line-up after serving as a primary reserve her first two seasons. Muxiri, who missed all of last season with a torn ACL, joins Jordan as the Lady Monarchs other double digit scorer. The Luanda, Angola native is pouring in 11.5 points and shooting a team-best 57.1 percent from the floor.

SEEING DOUBLE:

Senior Lawona Davis was the first Lady Monarch to perform the double-double as she had 11 points and a game-high 10 boards in last week's loss at Virginia Tech. The 10 boards tied her career high which occurred in both meetings with CAA rival Towson last season. Her double-double was the third of her career with the other two also coming against the Tigers. Davis scored nine of her 11 points against the Hokies in the second half. Typically known for driving to the basket, she opened the second half draining back-to-back three's.

ADD ANOTHER TO THE RAFTERS

Want to know why Shantel Wilson changed her number to #13? On Tuesday, November 29th the Old Dominion athletic department will retire the fifth women's basketball jersey. Tracy Claxton's #15 will be raised rafters joining Lady Monarch legends Nancy Lieberman, Inge Nissen, Anne Donovan, Ticha Penicheiro, and Clarisse Machanguana. Claxton spent two seasons at Kansas before transferring to Old Dominion in 1983. During her two seasons, Old Dominion went 55-8 culminating as Tournament MVP at the 1985 NCAA Championship. The 6-1 forward from New Haven, Connecticut is sixth on Old Dominion's all-time scoring leaders list just shy of the 2,000 point mark with 1,999 career points. Her 1434 career rebounds place her third on the all-time list. Claxton scored a career high 28 points against UCLA and grabbed 20 rebounds twice during her career, the first against Long Beach State in 1984, and the second in the 1985 NCAA final against Georgia. Her 37 rebounds collected during the national semifinals and finals are still at Final Four record 20 years later. Overall, she performed the double-double 37 times. Claxton earned All-District honors in 1984 and 1985 and she was named All-American in 1984 and 1985 by the National Sports Federation. She graduated from ODU in 1985 with a degree in Health and Physical Education.

POST-SEASON STARTS HERE:

Old Dominion will once again host the NCAA Women's Basketball Tournament First and Second Rounds at the Ted Constant Convocation Center in March. While the Ted Constant Convocation Center has played host to the First and Second Rounds in 2003 and the Regional in 2004, this year's tournament is the second year of using the new format with eight teams coming to the Tidewater area to vying for two spots in the "Sweet 16". The first round will take place on Sunday, March 19th and the second round will be played on Tuesday, March 21st. Old Dominion season ticket holders have until Dec. 1 to purchase tickets to receive a \$10 discount off the general admission tournament book. Tournament books are now priced at only \$35 for season ticket holders through Dec. 1, which includes admission to 4 games on Sunday, March 21 and two games on Tuesday, March 21. WELCOME NEW FACES:

If you look over at the bench on Sunday, you may notice some new faces on the Lady Monarch coaching staff. Wendy Larry welcomes back Susan Montgomery along with new assistant coaches Karen Barefoot, Marie Christian, and Director of Basketball Operations Sarah Teachey. Susan Montgomery begins her fifth season with Old Dominion. Montgomery was on maternity leave at the end of the last season as she welcomed her daughter, Reece Bailey. Barefoot is no stranger to the Hampton Roads area having been an All-American standout at Christopher Newport in Newport News and the head coach of the national championship team at the Apprentice School in 2001. Barefoot comes to Old Dominion having served as the head coach at Division II Lenoir-Rhyne for the last four seasons. As a former student-athlete at Christopher Newport, Barefoot still holds the recognition of being the only player in NCAA history, male or female, to score over 2,000 points and accumulate 1,000 assists. For four straight seasons she led the nation in assists and is CNU's all-time leader in scoring, assists, and steals. Christian is a former ODU standout, two-time captain and the 1985 Sun Belt Conference MVP. Her name can still be found in the record books listed third in all-time assists with 492, right behind Lady Monarch legends Nancy Lieberman and Ticha Penicheiro. Christian began her coaching career in 1992 serving as an assistant at Western Illinois followed by stints at the University of Dayton and the University of California. As a freshman, Christian was named MVP of the Sun Belt Conference Tournament and was invited to tryout for the United States Olympic Team. Sarah Teachey joins the Lady Monarchs for her first season in the newly created role of Director of Basketball Operations. The newest addition to the Lady Monarch family comes to Old Dominion after spending the last three seasons working with the Seattle Storm, most recently as the Senior Coordinator of Community Relations and Promotions.

COLONIAL DOMINANCE: Old Dominion has captured 14-straight Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) titles since joining the league from the Sun Belt Conference during the 1991-92 season. The Lady Monarchs are in the NCAA record books for capturing the most consecutive conference championships. In league play, Old Dominion holds a 251-14 overall record, which includes eight seasons of undefeated play. The Lady Monarchs hold a 134-2 record at home and a 117-12 road record. Only two CAA losses have occurred on Old Dominion's homecourt. The first was back at the ODU Fieldhouse, the former Lady Monarch homecourt from 1969-2002, against Richmond, now of the Atlantic-10, with a 70-74 defeat on February 19, 1992 and the second versus Delaware with a 70-73 setback on January 9, 2005. Five schools in the league have yet to beat the Lady Monarchs - Georgia State (0-0), George Mason (36-0), Northeastern (1-0), UNC-Wilmington (32-0), and Towson (8-0).
